The IECMHC Network services are offered at **no cost** to child care and early education programs and home-based providers.





Areas of Support Include:

- **Promoting** positive mental health and social and emotional development.
- Addressing behavior that providers find concerning or challenging.
- **Developing** a program culture that promotes the well-being of providers, children, and families.
- Focusing on relationships and practices that buffer against stress and trauma.
